In 1952 Michael Ventris deciphered the script found on the Linear B tablets from Crete and the Greek mainland, thereby revealing the earliest known form of Greek. In 1956 he and John Chadwick published *Documents in Mycenaean Greek*, which gave an account of the decipherment, of the language of the tablets, of the society and economy revealed by the documents, and a series of chapters giving texts, translations and commentary of the most important tablets. Though partially updated in 1973, *Documents* is now very much outdated: there has been a vast accrual of bibliography on the subject since 1973 and discoveries of tablets at new sites. This new survey, written by fourteen of the world's leading experts, will bring the reader fully up to date with developments in all aspects of Mycenaean studies, concluding with a new glossary of all the more complete Mycenaean words.

John Killen F.B.A. is Emeritus Professor of Mycenaean Greek, Cambridge University. He collaborated with John Chadwick, Jean-Pierre Olivier and others on the *Corpus of Mycenaean Inscriptions from Knossos* (4 vols, 1986–98), and his collected papers on Linear B were edited by Maurizio Del Freo (3 vols, 2015).

PREFACE

In 2003 Anna Morpurgo Davies and I were invited by Michael Sharp of Cambridge University Press to undertake the compilation of a new edition of *Documents in Mycenaean Greek*. The task was a daunting one: *Documents*, published in 1956 by Michael Ventris, the decipherer of Linear B, and his linguistic collaborator John Chadwick, and written in an astonishingly short space of time, is distinguished for its learning, its mastery of Linear B in all its aspects, its excellent judgement and its pellucid presentation, and rapidly became established as the ‘bible’ of Linear B; while John Chadwick’s second edition (1973), which preserves nearly all of the first edition, to which he adds an ‘Additional Commentary’ of 139 pages, together with a new glossary, bibliography, index and set of concordances, is the work of a master of his subject, and shows the same qualities of learning, clarity and sound judgement as the original book. But in the years since 1956, much of the detail of *Documents*¹ has become outdated; and even since 1973 there has been a vast increase in the bibliography of the subject. It was clear to us therefore, in contemplating the task that would lie before us if we accepted the Press’s invitation, that we should have to write more or less a new book; and that if we were to complete the volume in reasonable time we should have to enlist the help of a number of colleagues, each expert in different aspects of the subject. On this basis, we decided to embark on the task, and set about selecting the texts for comment in Part III of the book and drawing up a list of scholars we wished to see contributing to the project. It is pleasing to report that almost all those approached were able to accept our invitation to participate; and warm thanks are due to all our authors for the promptness with which they have submitted their chapters, and for keeping closely to the guidelines that we set them for their contributions.

* * *

Because of her many other commitments at the time, Anna Davies was unable to contribute to the early stages of writing and editing the book, though she provided wise advice when certain problems arose. She was determined, however, to contribute substantially to the later stages of the project. Tragically, however, her wishes were frustrated, first by serious illness and then by her death on 27 September 2014. She is very greatly missed by Linear B scholars and philologists more widely for her profound knowledge of the Greek language and

its Proto-Indo-European origins, for her penetrating intelligence and shrewd judgement, and for the great clarity of her thought and expression.

This editor has yet to catch up with the digital revolution and has had to rely on the kindness of others for help with the parts of the book which involve an IT element. Maurizio Del Freo produced the ideogram ‘boxes’, one or more of which can be found in each of the text chapters, and also arranged for the transmission, each carefully annotated, of the drawings of the tablets by Louis Godart which appear in Part II. Rupert Thompson added the annotations in the left-hand margins of pages, for an explanation of which see the ‘Note on Marginal Annotations’ on p. xvii. He also, most helpfully, created a ‘skeleton’ of the Glossary in which words were assigned their *New Documents* tablet numbers. Moreed Arbabzadah, besides Herculean labours on the bibliography, helped in a great number of other ways. Anna Judson inserted the Linear B signs into Michael Ventris’s Chapter II.

To all these I owe heartfelt thanks. And I owe a particular debt of gratitude to the person without whom the book would never have been completed. Over the years in which it has been in preparation, Denise Bilton has turned my scruffy scribblings into elegant typescript with phenomenal accuracy and an eagle eye for inconsistency which has saved me from many errors. Thank you, Denise, for all your help, and for your patience and good humour throughout the process.

The reader may be disappointed to learn that, unlike another technologically challenged Cambridge author who notes in his preface that he had written his ms. with a fountain pen before handing it to the Faculty secretary to type, this author has written his material with a pen of the kind that was brought to perfection by that distinguished Argentinian–Hungarian inventor, Mr László Bíró.

Besides those who helped with IT, several colleagues have kindly read and commented on draft chapters for me. NOTE ON CONSISTENCY

Whereas contributors to the book have been asked to follow certain guidelines regarding the presentation of their chapters, e.g. the form of their bibliographical references, no attempt has been made to impose standardisation in cases where there is more than one possible view of a matter, as in the following cases:

TEXTUAL NOTES

1. *Transcription of a Mycenaean term.* Among the cases in point here are the transcriptions of the word *do-e-ro*, ‘servant, slave’. Scholars regularly transcribe this both as /*doelos*/ and as /*dohelos*/; since, however, there is no evidence to confirm that the word did involve a medial /*h*/, no decision is made as to which to prefer.
2. *Technical terminology.* In *Documents*¹ Ventris and Chadwick use the term ‘ideogram’ to refer to the pictorial signs used in the script to denote commodities. Some scholars prefer to retain this term, but others prefer ‘logogram’. Since it is arguable which should be preferred (for discussion, see Ch. IV.4), no decision is made in the book between them.

NOTE ON ABSOLUTE VALUES OF THE SYMBOLS FOR WEIGHT AND VOLUME

Except where stated otherwise, the absolute values of the symbols for weight and volume that are adopted in the book are those found in *Documents*¹. For further discussion, see Chs IV.6, IV.7.
